		Henderson congratulated DVC on hiring Susan Lamb as their new college president.

		 Goehring said CCC has concerns that some of their drama courses are on list for no repeat but several of DVC's similar drama courses are not. Council agree it is Important for deans to check their lists periodically for accuracy and updates. Council agreed there needs to be clarification in how these decisions are made. McBrien will forward and email how the decisions for performance courses were made. Henderson suggested calling a meeting with this Council and the college curriculum chairs to discuss any changes that have been made to their curriculum and courses listed in the families. Last year the process for this was not fully resolved. Goehring said she had worked with Montemeyer-Lenz before she left her position to tighten up the changes. She said the senate presidents should check with their curriculum chairs to see if they have reviewed the process and changes. Council discussed some clarifications that are needed in the MOU. McBrien said she has some concerns with item 7 in the MOU under the District-wide process. She said it reads that discipline faculty from the requesting college will be invited to attend the meeting. However, the faculty in that discipline at the other colleges may disagree. Goehring said the working could be changed to "if invited". McBrien said it needs to be made clear the Curriculum Committee at the requesting college was unanimous in the decision. She suggested simplifying the language that the college that does not agree may invite discipline faculty as needed. The vote would be a simple majority of the DW Repeatability Group (senate presidents, curriculum chairs and a district representative). Goehring will reword it and send back to the Curriculum chairs for review and then bring it back to this Council

		Board Policy 2735 and Administrative Policy 2735 are a new policy and procedure that were created in response to a Board member's misunderstanding of travel budget allocations and reimbursements. Goehring said the Board has discussed raising their travel stipend which is what they are supposed to use for travel if the district has not asked them to do the travel. Council would like to verify the current travel stipend for the Governing Board. Goehring would like to find out how much the stipend is currently.
9:20-9:40	6.	CI4001 CREDIT HOUR MODIFICATIONS Council reviewed CI 4001 Standards of Scholarship. They agreed the language needs to be consistent regarding pass/no pass credit. Henderson said they were told they could not offer class auditing. Goehring said that is not correct and there is a policy on that. Council agreed to put this topic on a future consultation agenda. put on future consultation agenda McBrien said she would also like to discuss variable units. Henderson said they should review CI 4001 for other changes that might be needed. McBrien said DVC's policy on auditing is a contract for students to pay a certain fee to audit a class. Goehring said at CCC theirs is similar but auditing students are not placed on the rosters until they have submitted all their paperwork and paid the fees. Henderson thinks there may be some liabilities in allowing auditing and how it is offered.
