District Office Parking

Limited visitor parking is available around the base of the office building. If you do not have a college parking permit, you should obtain a temporary permit from the reception desk if you use the District Office lot.

In addition to the parking lots shown below, there is metered on-street parking throughout the downtown area.



Free public parking. There is a free bus that will take you to Ferry Street. The two lots by the Bocce Ball courts are well-maintained lots. The parking lot by Waterfront Park is poorly maintained (a lot of pot holes); however, if walking to District Office, it is the most convenient. There is an asphalt footpath that takes you from the lot to Ferry Street.

A metered parking lot. However, this is a cheap lot—only 25 cents an hour. Four hours = \$1.00. Also, the meters are 10-hour meters. Consequently, you can park in the lot all day and only feed the meter once.
