RESOLUTION DECLARING SEPTEMBER 17, 2025, AS CONSTITUTION DAY

WHEREAS, educational institutions receiving federal funding are required to hold an educational program pertaining to the United States Constitution on September 17 of each year, commemorating the September 17, 1787, signing of the Constitution; and

WHEREAS, by statute, September 17 of each year is to be designated as Constitution Day (also referred to as Citizenship Day); and

WHEREAS, community leaders are encouraged to reflect on the importance of active citizenship, recognize the enduring strength of our Constitution, and reaffirm our commitment to the rights and obligations of its citizens; and

WHEREAS, the Contra Costa Community College District (4CD) serves over 50,000 students annually, and has a mission of delivering innovative, high-quality educational programs and services that will empower all students to fulfill their educational and career aspirations and to understand and exercise their constitutional rights and civic duties; and

WHEREAS, 4CD pursues its vision by focusing on educational excellence, supporting social justice, diversity, equity, inclusion and belonging and contributing to the economic vitality for all its students and the surrounding community.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the 4CD Governing Board affirms September 17, 2025, as Constitution Day.
