College District pathways to success The new District Office at 500 Court Street, Martinez, CA, is dedicated as the George R. Gordon Education Center in 1972.




The Women's Re-entry Program started at DVC in September

LMC officially opens at its permanent facility in Pittsburg in 1974.












In 1977, Classified employees decide to be represented by United Classified Employees (UCE) and Local 1. In 1978, UCE affiliates with Local 1.




