Governing Board Meeting of March 28, 2012

The Contra Costa Community College District (CCCCD) Governing Board met at the George R. Gordon Education Center on March 28, 2012. The public meeting began at 5:00 p.m. with a reception honoring newly tenured faculty and the District's selection for Classified Employee of the Year, followed by the public session that began at 6:00 p.m.

Highlights of the meeting follow.

Reception for Tenured Faculty Reception and Classified Employee of the Year

The Governing Board attended a reception held at the District Office for newly tenured faculty. In addition, they recognized Kim Christiana, the District's nominee for the State Chancellor's Classified Employee of the Year award.

2012 Bond Measure Voter Opinion Polling Research

A special report on the 2012 bond measure voter opinion poll conducted by Alex Evans of EMC Research was presented to the Governing Board. In addition, the Governing Board heard from Eugene Clark-Herrera, Partner, and John Palmer, Associate, Public Finance, from Orrick, Herrington & Sutcliffe LLP on the timing and requirements in preparing for a bond measure or a parcel tax.

New Agreements Approved

The Governing Board approved a number of agreements including:

- a new Diablo Valley College (DVC) agreement with the Contra Costa County Office of Education to participate in the Medi-Cal Administrative Activities program which draws down federal funds for work performed connecting students with Medi-Cal insurance and sponsored health;
- a District renewal agreement with James Marta & Company to provide a comprehensive District audit, including three foundations, bond financial and performance audits and other post-employee benefits trust; and
- a new Los Medanos College (LMC) agreement with Kaiser Permanente Hospital to provide clinical experience for students enrolled in the nursing program.

The Governing Board approved new members to the Measure A Bond Oversight Committee as follows.
