Governing Board Meeting of October 8, 2014

The Contra Costa Community College District (District) Governing Board met at the George R. Gordon Education Center on October 8, 2014. The meeting began with closed session at 4:30 p.m., followed by the public meeting at 6:00 p.m. Highlights of the meeting follow.

New Agreements Approved

The Governing Board approved a number of agreements including:

- a new Contra Costa College (CCC) agreement with Arcadia Ambulance to provide ride-along experiences for emergency medical technician (EMT) students;
- a Diablo Valley College (DVC) renewal agreement with California State University, East Bay, to provide experience for students who want to become math and science teachers;
- a new District Office (DO) agreement with iParq Intelligent Parking to provide a computerized parking control issuance and enforcement system with ancillary services; and
- a new Los Medanos College (LMC) agreement with the Antioch Unified School District to provide a math faculty member to collaborate with teachers at Deer Valley High School to develop, implement and revise algebra curriculum to meet state standards.

Out-of-State Field Trip

The Governing Board approved an out-of-state field trip for eight CCC students to travel to Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, to attend the National College Media Convention from October 29, 2014, to November 2, 2014. All costs will be paid for by the students and through donations.

Student Success and Support Program Plans

The Governing Board received updates from CCC, DVC and LMC on their plans to increase student success through the use of state-funded Student Success and Support Program funds.

The meeting was adjourned in the memory of Judi Watkins, former Regional Training Institute administrative analyst.
