Governing Board Study Session/Regular Meeting of November 11, 2015

The Contra Costa Community College District (District) Governing Board met at the George R. Gordon Education Center on November 11, 2015. The study session/regular meeting began with open session at 3:00 p.m., followed by closed session at 8:30 p.m.

Highlights of the meeting follow.

Veterans Day Observance

The Governing Board held a special Veterans Day observance and recognized employee veterans and supporters of the District's Veterans Centers, heard presentations by elected officials, and approved a resolution supporting veterans.

Student Services and Support Update

College representatives gave the Governing Board an update on strategies being deployed to improve student success as a result of student services and support program funding.

Accomplishments toward 2014-15 Strategic Directions

The Governing Board heard updates on the implementation of Assembly Bill (AB288), College and Career Access Pathways Partnership and how the District is progressing toward the 2014-15 strategic directions.

New Agreements Approved

The Governing Board approved a number of agreements, including:

- a new Contra Costa College (CCC) agreement with New Creation Studio to provide services relating to the redesign of the college's website;
- a new Diablo Valley College (DVC) agreement with Oakland Unified School District to provide instructional services relating to library technology courses;

- a new District Office agreement with Van Dermyden Maddux Law Corporation to provide legal services; and
- a new Los Medanos College (LMC) agreement with National Student Clearinghouse to provide tracking services for purposes of reporting enrollment status.

The meeting was adjourned in memory of Glenn Davidson, retired CCC computer science professor, Harold Keck, CCC administrative of justice professor, and Alice Parks, retired CCC nursing professor.
