Governing Board Regular Meeting of October 7, 2015

The Contra Costa Community College District (District) Governing Board met at the George R. Gordon Education Center on October 7, 2015. The regular meeting began with closed session at 5:05 p.m., followed by open session at 6:00 p.m.

Highlights of the meeting follow.

Employee Morale Survey

The Governing Board heard a presentation from PricewaterhouseCoopers' Alberto Rocha on the administration and planning of the District's employee morale survey.

New Agreements Approved

The Governing Board approved a number of agreements including:

- a Contra Costa College (CCC) renewal agreement with West Contra Costa Unified School District to provide instructional services to the alternative education high school, Gateway to College;
- a Diablo Valley College (DVC) renewal agreement with University of California, Davis, to provide support services to increase the number of transfer-ready students;
- a District Office renewal agreement with the Chancellor's Office Tax Offset Program to collect unpaid enrollment fees and financial aid overpayments; and
- a new Los Medanos College (LMC) agreement with San Francisco State University to participate in a faculty enhancement program for current and aspiring community college biology instructors.

Out of State Field Trips

The Governing Board approved three out-of-state field trips for students at CCC and LMC.

- Five CCC students will travel to Reno, Nevada, to participate in a speech and debate tournament hosted by the University of Nevada, Reno, from October 16, 2015, to October 18, 2015.
- Nine CCC students will travel to Austin, Texas, to participate in the National College Media Convention from October 29, 2015, to November 1, 2015.

- Four LMC students will travel to National Harbor, Maryland, to participate in the Society for Advancing Chicano and Native American Scientists from October 28, 2015, to November 1, 2015.

Accreditation Follow-up Reports

After review and discussion, the Governing Board approved the final accreditation follow-up reports for CCC, DVC and LMC.

America's College Promise Resolution

The Governing Board approved the resolution for America's College Promise, President Obama's proposal for a free community college education for all responsible and qualified students.

The meeting was adjourned in the memory of Carol Yacorzynski, DVC senior account clerk.
