The Contra Costa Community College District (District) Governing Board met at the George R. Gordon Education Center on October 18, 2016. The special meeting began at 9:00 a.m. and was held to discuss the following topic.

Governing Board Vacancy

The Governing Board reviewed Board Policy 1021 and Administrative Procedure 1021.1, <u>Vacancies on the Governing Board</u>, and discussed how to fill the Governing Board position following the passing of John T. Nejedly. The Governing Board decided to proceed with a provisional appointment for Ward IV. This process will involve review and discussion of all applications at one meeting, followed by a second special meeting to interview three finalists. If there is no consensus, the District will move forward to fill the position with a special election. The Governing Board asked the human resources department to handle the receipt and checking of all applications.
