

Governing Board Study Session/ Regular Meeting of July 26, 2017

The Contra Costa Community College District (District) Governing Board met at the George R. Gordon Education Center on July 26, 2017. The study session/regular meeting began with closed session at 3:00 p.m., followed by public session at 4:00 p.m.

Highlights of the meeting follow.

Workforce Education and Career Pathways Study Session

The Governing Board conducted a study session on progress being made in the areas of workforce education and career pathways, noting the correlation that higher education can have on increasing salaries in the workforce.

New Agreements Approved

The Governing Board unanimously approved a number of agreements, including:

- a Contra Costa College renewal agreement with The Regents of the University of California for the Puente Project;
- a Diablo Valley College (DVC) renewal agreement with the Carnegie Foundation to provide professional development opportunities for the Advancement of Teaching program;
- a District Office renewal agreement with Regroup to provide emergency notification platform services for students and staff through various methods; and
- a Los Medanos College renewal agreement with the University of California, Davis, for the Transfer Opportunity Program.

Profile for DVC President Recruitment

The Governing Board reviewed and gave approval to the Profile for the President of DVC. This recruitment will begin on July 27, 2017.

The meeting was adjourned in memory of Willard Calhoun, retired DVC counselor and psychology professor.
