Governing Board Regular Meeting of June 27, 2018

The Contra Costa Community College District (District) Governing Board met at the George R. Gordon Education Center on June 27, 2018. The regular meeting began at 5:00 p.m. with closed session, followed by the public meeting at 6:00 p.m.

Highlights of the meeting follow.

New Student Trustee

Governing Board President John E. Márquez administered the oath of office to new Student Trustee Jocelyn Villalobos.

New Agreements Approved

The Governing Board approved a number of agreements, including:

- a Contra Costa College (CCC) renewal agreement with Richmond Community Foundation to provide SparkPoint services that will include financial services to support student persistence, such as budgeting, credit and financial coaching;
- a Diablo Valley College renewal agreement with John F. Kennedy University to provide facilities for the Emeritus College;
- a District renewal agreement with Managed Health Network to provide services for the Employee Assistance Program; and
- a Los Medanos College renewal agreement with University of California, Davis, for the Transfer Opportunity Program.

Approval by the Governing Board was given to dispose of the following District surplus property:
