Governing Board Regular Meeting/Study Session of November 8, 2017

The Contra Costa Community College District (District) Governing Board met at the George R. Gordon Education Center on November 8, 2017. The public meeting began with closed session at 3:00 p.m., followed by the study session/meeting at 4:00 p.m.

Highlights of the meeting follow.

Student Progress Report

The Governing Board held a study session on the progress the colleges are making towards student success/ It was led by Interim Associate Vice Chancellor, Educational Services Gregory Stoup.

New Agreements Approved

The Governing Board approved a number of agreements including:

- a new Contra Costa College (CCC) agreement with ESCALA Educational Services LLC to provide faculty with professional development and training on pedagogical techniques and culturally relevant behaviors to foster greater student success in mathematics at CCC;
- a Diablo Valley College (DVC) renewal agreement with the Contra Costa County Office of Education to establish the responsibilities as a member district in serving the Contra Costa County Adult Education Consortium;
- a District Office renewal agreement with R.V. Stutzman Consulting to provide consulting services relating to the District's facilities planning; and
- a new Los Medanos College agreement with West Ed to provide a professional development workshop on reading Apprenticeship.

Out-of-State Field Trips

The Governing Board approved two out-of-state field trips for six DVC students to attend the the National Student Leadership Diversity Convention from February 2, 2018, to February 4, 2018, in Salt Lake City, Utah, and for ten DVC students to attend the National Student Advocacy Conference from March 16, 2018, to March 21, 2018, in Washington, D.C.
