## Governing Board Regular Meeting/Study Session July 25, 2018

The Contra Costa Community College District (District) Governing Board met at the George R. Gordon Education Center on July 25, 2018. The study session/regular meeting began at 3:00 p.m. with closed session, followed by the public meeting at 4:00 p.m.

Highlights of the meeting follow.

### District Strategic Plan

The Governing Board held a study session to provide their input on the development of the 2020-2024 District Strategic Plan.

### New Agreements Approved

The Governing Board approved a number of agreements, including:

- a new Contra Costa College (CCC) agreement with Santa Clarita Community College District to receive funding to support the colleges' enrollment management practices and planning and development of Guided Pathways work;
- a Diablo Valley College renewal agreement with the Native American Health Center to provide clinical experience for students in the Dental Hygiene Program;
- a District renewal agreement with Regroup to provide emergency notification platform services for students and staff through various methods; and
- a Los Medanos College (LMC) renewal agreement with Contra Costa Health Services to provide clinical experience for students in the EMT, medical assistant, nursing, office technician and paramedic training programs.

### Citizens' Bond Oversight Committee Member

Lee Bateman was given Governing Board approval to be placed on the Measure A 2006 and Measure E 2014 Citizens' Bond Oversight Committee as a LMC Support Organization Representative. This is his first term, which runs from July 1, 2018, through June 30, 2020.

### **Constitution Day Resolution**

By a unanimous decision, the Governing Board approved a resolution recognizing September 17, 2018, as Constitution Day (or Citizenship Day), an American federal observance day that recognizes the adoption of the U.S. Constitution and those who have become U.S. citizens.
