Governing Board Meeting of September 12, 2018

The Contra Costa Community College District (District) Governing Board met at the George R. Gordon Education Center on September 12, 2018. The meeting began at 5:00 p.m. with closed session, followed by the public meeting at 6:00 p.m.

2018-19 Adoption Budget

The Governing Board held a public hearing and then approved the District's 2018-19 adoption budget.

New Agreements Approved

The Governing Board approved a number of agreements, including:

- a Contra Costa College renewal agreement with Hayward & Willett Evaluation to provide research study services in order to be eligible to receive funding as part of the Hispanic Serving Institution STEM grant competition;
- a new Diablo Valley College agreement with Carpenters Training Committee for Northern California to establish mutual goals and responsibilities to train participants for entry into the Northern California Carpenters Pre-Apprenticeship Program;
- a new District agreement with Contra Costa Economic Partnership to provide human resources capital support and develop functionality as part of the Strong Workforce Program; and
- a new Los Medanos College (LMC) agreement with Food Bank of Contra Costa and Solano Counties to enable the LMC Food Pantry to receive food account credit for eligible students as part of the CalFresh Incentive Program.

The meeting was adjourned in memory of Richard (Dick) E. Kamprath, retired DVC music professor.
