Governing Board Study Session/Public Meeting of November 13, 2019

The Contra Costa Community College District (District) Governing Board met at the George R. Gordon Education Center on November 13, 2019. The study session/regular meeting began at 3:00 p.m. with closed session, followed by public session at 4:00 p.m.

High School Graduation and Outreach

The Governing Board heard a presentation on the enrollment and success of recent high school graduates within the District's service area.

New Agreements Approved

The Governing Board approved a number of agreements, including:

- a new Contra Costa College (CCC) agreement with the Oakland Vet Center to provide mental health services/readjustment counseling to eligible veteran students;
- a new Diablo Valley College (DVC) agreement with Rainbow Community Center to provide 12 LGBTQ and cultural humility training sessions for students and staff;
- a District renewal agreement with Community Violence Solutions and the Rape Crisis Center to work with District police services providing assistance for crime victims; and
- a new Los Medanos College (LMC) agreement with Conscious Discipline to provide training and coaching on the powers and skills of conscious discipline for early childhood education staff.
