Governing Board Special Meeting October 9, 2019

The Contra Costa Community College District (District) Governing Board met at the George R. Gordon Education Center on October 9, 2019. The regular meeting began at 5:00 p.m. with closed session, followed by public session at 6:00 p.m.

New Agreements Approved

The Governing Board approved a number of agreements, including:

- a new Diablo Valley College (DVC) agreement with Mt. Diablo Unified School District to establish a STEM Academy in alignment with DVC's certificate and degree pathways in manufacturing/engineering as part of the CCAP STEM Pathways grant from the California Community College Chancellor's Office;
- a District renewal agreement with McCallum Group, Inc., to provide consulting services and legislative updates for the District; and
- a new Los Medanos College (LMC) agreement with the Regents of the University of California to facilitate the transfer of California Community College students to California public four-year universities by providing accurate and up-to-date articulation information.

Out-of-State Field Trips

The listed out-of-state field trips approved by the Governing Board will allow students to attend various conferences and competitions.

- Six CCC students will travel to Washington, D.C., to attend the 2019 National College Media Convention from October 30-November 4, 2019.
- Nine DVC students will travel to Peoria, Illinois, to attend the annual "The Norton" Speech and Debate Invitational at Bradley University from November 1-4, 2019.

- 24 LMC students will travel to Fort Collins, Colorado, to present and compete at a national conference; participate in professional development; and establish scholarship and transfer agreements with four-year universities from February 17-21, 2020.
