Governing Board Regular Meeting of June 23, 2021

The Contra Costa Community College District (4CD) Governing Board conducted a remote regular meeting on Wednesday, June 23, 2021, beginning at 5:00 p.m., followed by closed session, and continuation of public session at 6:00 p.m.

New Student Trustee Austin Green

Governing Board President Andy Li administered the oath of office to newly elected Student Trustee and Los Medanos College (LMC) student Austin Green.

LGBTQIA+ Resolution Approved

The Governing Board unanimously approved a resolution recognizing June 2021 as LGBTQIA+ Pride Month. 4CD also celebrated this month by flying the Pride Flag at the District Office and colleges.

New Agreements Approved

The Governing Board approved a number of agreements, including:

- a new Contra Costa College agreement to offer or expand dual enrollment opportunities consistent with the provisions of AB 30;
- a new Diablo Valley College (DVC) agreement with Santa Clarita Community College District to develop and implement a marketing plan, outreach events, and transfer and career education programs designed for students in the 25 and older population in order to improve enrollment and retention within this demographic;
- a 4CD renewal agreement with Contra Costa Economic Partnership to provide support services to accomplish Strong Workforce Program goals regarding work-based learning employment outcomes; and
- a LMC renewal agreement with Chabot-Las Positas Community College District to provide coordination, development and implementation of the California mentor program.

Recognition of Juneteenth

The Governing Board applauded President Biden and the U.S. Congress for recognizing Juneteenth as a nationally recognized holiday. This date is celebrated annually to commemorate the emancipation of enslaved people in the United States.

2021-22 Tentative Budget

The Governing Board received a presentation on the 2021-22 Tentative Budget, and unanimously approved it.

Contract for Reenrollment Campaign

The Governing Board voted to approve staff's recommendation to develop a contract with Interact Communications to help lead 4CD's three-year enrollment campaign. This contract will be placed on the Governing Board's July 14, 2021, agenda for review and approval.

College and Career Access Pathways (CCAP) Agreements

The Governing Board approved the renewal of CCAP Agreements with 26 Contra Costa County unified school districts, and one new agreement with the Martinez Unified School District.

The meeting was adjourned in memory of Rich Wilbanks, retired DVC political science instructor.
