Governing Board Regular Meeting/Study Session of November 11, 2020

The Contra Costa Community College District Governing Board conducted a remote regular meeting/study session on Wednesday, November 11, 2020, beginning with closed session at 3:00 p.m., followed by the public meeting/study session at 4:00 p.m.

High School Graduation and Outreach

The Governing Board heard a presentation from District Educational Services staff on the enrollment and success of recent high school graduates within the District's service area.

New Agreements Approved

The Governing Board approved a number of agreements, including:

- a Contra Costa College renewal agreement with American Medical Response to provide clinical experience for EMT students;
- a new Diablo Valley College agreement with Orion Academy to provide a three-unit class in the spring 2021 semester;
- a new District agreement with Rancho Solano Community College District to support the work of the Strong Workforce Program initiative; and
- a Los Medanos College (LMC) renewal agreement with Contra Costa County, Employment and Human Services to conduct foster pride/adopt pride curriculum workshops.

2021-22 Academic Calendar Approved

The Governing Board approved the 2021-22 Academic Calendar that already received support from United Faculty and Local 1. It was noted that going forward in 2021, Veterans Day will be observed Districtwide on November 11.

Educational Master Plan

LMC staff presented and received Governing Board approval of their *2020-25 Educational Master Plan*, which functions as the blueprint for the college's organizational development and the fulfillment of its mission.

Sustainability Report

Facilities staff shared a presentation highlighting the Districtwide progress on sustainability throughout the 2019-20 fiscal year.

Veterans Resolution Approved
