Governing Board Regular Meeting of October 14, 2020

The Contra Costa Community College District Governing Board conducted a remote regular meeting on Wednesday, October 14, 2020, beginning with closed session at 5:00 p.m., followed by the public meeting at 6:00 p.m.

New Agreements Approved

The Governing Board approved a number of agreements, including:

- a new Contra Costa College (CCC) agreement with Cygnus Planning, to assist in developing a new Strategic Educational Master Plan;
- a Diablo Valley College renewal agreement with Food Bank of Contra Costa and Solano to provide non-perishable and perishable food to college pantries that serve students in need and their families;
- a new District agreement with Global Financial Aid Services, Inc., for student financial aid verification software; and
- a new Los Medanos College agreement with John F. Kennedy University to provide school-based therapeutic counseling to students.

Contract for Dr. Bryan Reece

The Governing Board approved the contract for Dr. Bryan Reece to become the District's ninth permanent Chancellor. The contract calls for an annual salary of \$315,000.00, with employment beginning on November 1, 2020.

Resolutions Approved

The Governing Board unanimously approved the following resolutions:

- Undocumented Student Week of Action, October 19-23, 2020;
- National Hispanic Heritage Month Resolution, September 15 to October 15, 2020; and
- October as Filipino History Month: The History of Filipino American Activism.

The meeting was adjourned in memory of Ruth Schifferle, retired nursing professor, and Chizu Iiyama, retired CCC Director of Early Childhood Education.
