

Governing Board Regular Meeting of December 15, 2021

The Contra Costa Community College District (4CD) Governing Board conducted a regular meeting on Wednesday, December 15, 2021, beginning at 5:30 p.m., followed by closed session, and continuation of public session at 6:00 p.m.

Annual Organizational Meeting

The Governing Board held their annual organizational meeting and agreed to the following slate of officers for the 2022 term:

New Agreements Approved

The Governing Board approved a number of agreements, including:

- a Contra Costa College (CCC) renewal agreement with the Wright Institute to provide counseling and team-building support for Middle College high School students;
- a Diablo Valley College (DVC) renewal agreement with Study Abroad Association, LLC, to provide transportation, lodging, meals, and cultural experiences in Puebla, Mexico, as part of a study abroad program;
- a new 4CD agreement with Studee Ltd., to provide international student recruitment, marketing, consultation, advising and application support; and
- a new Los Medanos College (LMC) agreement with Certiport to provide QuickBooks courses to be used toward software certification.

Bond Issuance

The Governing Board gave approval to the sale of \$110,000,000 of general obligation bonds, and to refund up to \$100,000,000 of bonds previously sold to lower the cost to taxpayers.

The meeting was adjourned in memory of Eugene Goselin, retired CCC and DVC professor, and Marian Luoma, retired LMC assistant equipment manager.
