## Governing Board Regular Meeting of January 12, 2022

The Contra Costa Community College District (4CD) Governing Board conducted a regular meeting on Wednesday, January 12, 2022, beginning at 5:00 p.m., followed by closed session, and continuation of public session at 6:00 p.m.

### Ward Redistricting

After discussions at the regular meeting/study session of November 10, 2021, regular meeting of December 8, 2021 (first public hearing), and a special meeting on January 6, 2022, the Governing Board held a second public hearing on proposals to balance ward boundaries following the population changes identified in the 2020 Census. After listening to public comments, the Governing Board, by four aye votes and one abstention, approved a Resolution on Redistricting, using Ward Map #2, as recommended by staff.

### Special Presentation

The Governing Board heard about a successful Bachelor's Degree partnership between Los Medanos College and UMASS Global in Early Childhood Education. Several graduates of the program also shared their experiences and appreciation of the program.

### Out of State Field Trip

The Governing Board approved an out-of-state field trip for 14 Diablo Valley College (DVC) students to travel to St. Louis, Missouri, to represent the college at the Phi Rho Pi National Tournament from April 2 to April 10, 2022.

### Memorial Plaque

Approval by the Governing Board was given to place a plaque at the DVC-San Ramon Campus in memory of deceased Senior Dean Kathleen Costa for her contributions and leadership.

The meeting was adjourned in memory of DVC counselor/professor Lillian "Corina" Aguallo, and Richard (Rick) John Ida, former DVC professor.
