

Governing Board Regular Meeting/Study Session of May 11, 2022

The Contra Costa Community College District (4CD) Governing Board conducted a regular meeting/study session on Wednesday, May 11, 2022, beginning at 5:00 p.m., followed by closed session, and continuation of public session at 6:30 p.m.

2022-23 Budget Study Session

The Governing Board held their annual study session on the 2022-23 budget, including a review of the 2021-22 budget status.

2021-22 Student Trustee Recognized

The Governing Board thanked and recognized 2021-22 Student Trustee Austin Green for his service and contributions to 4CD. The newly elected Student Trustee will be sworn into office at the June Governing Board meeting.

Resolutions Approved

The following resolutions were unanimously approved by the Governing Board:

- Asian/Pacific American Heritage Month, May 2022;
- Mental Health Awareness Month, May 2022; and
- Continuing Governing Board Authority to Hold Virtual Meetings Pursuant to Assembly Bill 361.

Renewal Agreements Approved

The Governing Board approved a number of renewal agreements, including:

- coordination and training for the child care program at Contra Costa College in partnership with Yosemite Community College District;
- provision of non-perishable and perishable food for Diablo Valley College's (DVC)
 pantries to serve students in need as well as their families in partnership with the Food
 Bank of Contra Costa and Solano Counties;
- a Contra Costa Economic Partnership for 4CD that will provide support services to accomplish Strong Workforce Program goals regarding work-based learning employment outcomes; and
- compensation of duties performed by Los Medanos College professor Myra Snell as math lead for the California Acceleration Project, in partnership with the Foundation for California Community Colleges.

The meeting was adjourned in memory of Frederic Johnson, retired DVC music professor.
