

Governing Board Regular Meeting/Study Session of November 10, 2021

The Contra Costa Community College District (4CD) Governing Board conducted a regular meeting/study session on Wednesday, November 10, 2021, beginning at 5:00 p.m., followed by closed session, and continuation of public session at 6:00 p.m.

Recognition for LMC

The Governing Board acknowledged Los Medanos College (LMC) President Bob Kratochvil and his team on being selected by the Aspen Institute for the fourth time as a top 150 community college in the nation.

Strategic Direction 3 Study Session

The Governing Board heard a presentation that highlighted specific K-12 partnerships and early college credit programming at each of the colleges. In addition, information was shared on high school graduation and capture rates.

New Agreements Approved

The Governing Board approved a number of agreements, including:

- a new Contra Costa College (CCC) agreement with Tipping Point Community to implement equitable dual enrollment strategies in collaboration with K-12 partners;
- a Diablo Valley College (DVC) renewal agreement with University of California,
 Berkeley, for the Puente Project to increase student transfers to the university;
- a new 4CD agreement with Cornerstone OnDemand, to provide Cornerstone software performance suite, including customer and technical support services to enhance professional development; and
- a new LMC agreement with Aperture Content Marketing to provide customized template, content, printing and distribution of the 2022 Career Focus magazine.

Approval by the Governing Board was given to the 2022-23 Academic/Classified Calendar after receiving concurrence from United Faculty and Public Employees Union, Local 1.

Resolutions Approved

Three resolutions were approved by the Governing Board. They were:

- National Native American Heritage Month;
- Honoring Veterans and All Persons Currently Serving in the Armed Forces of the United States of America, Our Employee Veterans and Our Student Veterans; and
- Continuing Governing Board Authority to Hold Virtual Meetings Pursuant to Assembly Bill 361 Open Meetings: State and Local Conferences; Teleconferences
