

Governing Board Regular Meeting of October 13, 2021

The Contra Costa Community College District (4CD) Governing Board conducted a regular meeting on Wednesday, October 13, 2021, beginning at 5:00 p.m., followed by closed session, and continuation of public session at 6:00 p.m.

New Agreements Approved

The Governing Board approved a number of agreements, including:

- a new Contra Costa College (CCC) agreement with The Food Bank of Contra Costa and Solano to provide non-perishable and perishable food to college pantries that serve students in need and their families;
- a Diablo Valley College (DVC) renewal agreement with TimelyMD to provide telehealth and telemental services through an agreement with CollegeBuys and the Foundation for California Community College;
- a new 4CD agreement with Ready Education to provide software and technical support for contract tracing and vaccination data; and
- a new Los Medanos College agreement with Jewish Vocational and Career Counseling Service to provide instruction and support related to fall 2021 electronic instrumentation pre-apprenticeship.

Disposal of Surplus Property

The Governing Board approved the disposal of a 2008 Ford Escape Hybrid vehicle, surplus property.

Out-of-State Field Trips

Approval by the Governing Board was given for CCC students to participate in the following outof-state field trips:

- New Orleans, Louisiana approximately 18 to 22 students will participate in performances, workshops and university visits from April 29, 2022, to May 4, 2022.
- France approximately six students will participate in performances and workshops from May 28, 2022, to June 11, 2022.

Chancellor Contract

After completing the performance evaluation, the Governing Board unanimously approved a 2% salary increase for Chancellor Bryan Reece, effective July 1, 2021.
