## Governing Board Regular Meeting of August 10, 2022

The Contra Costa Community College District (4CD) Governing Board conducted a regular meeting on Wednesday, August 10, 2022, beginning at 5:00 p.m., followed by closed session, and continuation of public session at 6:00 p.m.

## **Purchasing Agreements Approved**

The Governing Board approved a number of agreements, including:

- a Contra Costa College (CCC) renewal agreement with the Richmond Community Foundation to provide SparkPoint services, including financial services that support student persistence, such as budgeting, credit and financial coaching;
- a new Diablo Valley College (DVC) agreement with Benicia Unified School District to allow students to complete their internship and work experience hours at K-12 sites;
- a 4CD renewal agreement with Contra Costa Health Services to provide COVID-19 vaccinations at CCC and DVC; and
- a Los Medanos College (LMC) renewal agreement with John F. Kennedy University to provide school-based therapeutic counseling services to students.

## Measure E 2014 Bond Oversight Committee Appointments

The Governing Board approved the following appointments to the 4CD Citizens' Bond Oversight Committee:

- Lee Bateman, LMC Support Organization Representative; and
- William van Dyk, CCC Support Organization Representative.

Both volunteers are serving a third consecutive term, which will end on June 30, 2024.

## Authorization to Sell General Obligation Bonds

A Resolution authorizing the issuance and sale of not to exceed \$110 million of General Obligation Bonds was unanimously approved by the Governing Board. Proceeds from the general obligation bonds will retire the Bond Anticipation Notes taken out earlier this year.

The meeting was adjourned in memory of Randy P. Connor, LMC Humanities adjunct professor, and Brian Johnson, former LMC student, who earned his A.A. degree and was a member of the Umoja Scholars Program.
