Special Reports

Listed below is information on a variety of special reports.

- Chairperson Elaine Schroth summarized the Citizens' Bond Oversight Committee annual report;
- MGI Advocacy President Mark MacDonald shared legislative update information and received input from the Governing Board on matters of interest;
- Dr. Sally Montemayor Lenz highlighted portions of the *Contra Costa Community College District Diversity, Equity, Inclusion, Belonging: Planning Framework and Resource Guide*; and
