Governing Board Regular Meeting of February 18, 2026

The Contra Costa Community College District (4CD) Governing Board conducted a regular meeting on Wednesday, February 18, 2026, beginning at 5:00 p.m., followed by closed session, and continuation of the public session at 6:00 p.m.

Measure E Report to the Community Presented by Bond Oversight Committee

On behalf of the Measure E Citizens' Bond Oversight Committee, committee member Rob Schroder presented the newly published 2025 Measure E report to the community. His comments highlighted the facilities improvements resulting from Measure E projects, affirmed the positive report from the recent bond audit, and thanked 4CD staff for their work on the capital projects and in partnering with the Oversight Committee.

Update on Colleges' Student Equity and Achievement Programs (SEAP)

Equity and research leaders and students from the colleges and District Office provided an overview of their program's respective achievements and lessons learned from the 2022-25 Student Equity Plans and presented priorities for the 2025-28 Student Equity Plans. The report highlighted how student equity efforts are integrated with the colleges' and 4CD's strategic planning and program review processes to advance equitable student outcomes.

Report on State Budget Implications for 4CD

Associate Vice Chancellor/Chief Financial Officer Dr. Tony Wold shared a report on potential 2026-27 budget implications for 4CD, based on the Governor's proposed state budget. Dr. Wold said that 4CD had finalized its budget assumptions and that District staff would provide formal budget presentations to employees at the colleges and District Office in April, with the tentative 4CD budget presented to the Governing Board in June.

Black History Month Resolution

The Governing Board adopted a resolution in honor of Black History Month. This year's theme is, "A Century of Black History Commemorations." Among the 4CD community, 10.7% of employees and 9.5% of students identify as Black or African American.

DVC and LMC to Host 2026 Commencement at Concord Pavilion

DVC and LMC announced they will hold their 2026 graduation ceremonies at the Toyota Pavilion at Concord. LMC will hold commencement in the morning, and DVC will hold commencement in the afternoon. The date for both events is Friday, May 22. CCC will also hold commencement on this same day on the college football field.
