Governing Board Regular Meeting of June 10, 2026

The Contra Costa Community College District (4CD) Governing Board conducted a regular meeting on Wednesday, June 10, 2026, beginning at 5:00 p.m., followed by closed session, and continuation of the public session at 6:00 p.m.

Governing Board Approves Tentative 2026-2027 Budget

In accordance with state law, the Governing Board approved a tentative 2026-2027 budget prior to its June 30 deadline. The \$265 million budget will be updated following the approval of the Governor's budget, which will determine how much revenue 4CD is expected to receive from the State.

Report on Impact of Federal Open Educational Resources (OER) Grant Shared

The Governing Board received a report highlighting the successful completion of the OER Expansion Project. This \$1 million federal grant was designed to increase equitable access to course materials, including textbooks, by supporting faculty in the adoption, adaptation, and creation of OER across 4CD's three colleges. Beyond affordability, the initiative empowered faculty to redesign course materials to be more inclusive, culturally responsive, and accessible, better reflecting the diversity of 4CD's student population.

New Student Trustee Takes Office

Student Trustee Nicholas ("Nick") Bonasera took the oath of office for his one-year term on the Governing Board. Nick is a political science student at Diablo Valley College, President of the Student Veterans Alliance, and a United States Marine Corps veteran who began his military career in 2018. Upon completion at Diablo Valley College, Nick plans to continue his education through graduate and professional studies in public policy and law.

Governing Board Approves Resolution Ordering Member Elections

Governing Board members in Wards 1, 3, and 4 have seats up for election on November 3, 2026. The Governing Board passed the Resolution Ordering Regular Governing Board Member Elections, and paperwork will be submitted to the County Clerk-Recorder Elections Department by July 1.

Governing Board Approves Resolution Recognizing LGBTQIA+ Pride Month

The Governing Board annually approves the Resolution in honor of Pride Month. 4CD recognizes that inclusive, affirming learning and working environments are essential to the well-being, academic success, and full participation of LGBTQIA+ students, faculty, staff, and community members, and views LGBTQIA+ inclusion as a vital part of advancing its Districtwide Diversity, Equity, Inclusion, Belonging, and Accessibility priorities.
