### **Governing Board Regular Meeting of May 13, 2026**

The Contra Costa Community College District (4CD) Governing Board conducted a regular meeting on Wednesday, May 13, 2026, beginning at 4:00 p.m., followed by closed session, and continuation of the public session at 6:00 p.m.

#### **Districtwide Facilities Planning and Sustainability Update Presented**

Vice Chancellor, Facilities Planning and Construction Ines Zildzic provided the annual update on 4CD's facilities and sustainability efforts, which included progress on Measure E bond projects and highlighted major non-bond and locally funded improvements underway Districtwide. Energy and Sustainability Manager Tracy Marcial and Utility and Sustainability Specialist Katherine Chen demonstrated progress toward 4CD's nine sustainability goals. Together, these updates offer a clear view of the current projects and emerging priorities, reinforcing 4CD's commitment to a high-quality, student-centered built environment and long-term sustainability.

Additionally, the Governing Board approved a Resolution Authorizing Districtwide Mechanical and Controls Upgrade Energy Efficiency Project, which will advance 4CD's energy conservation efforts by replacing aging and inefficient mechanical systems and building controls at Contra Costa College and Diablo Valley College.

#### **Student Trustee Recognized for Her Service**

In appreciation of her service as Student Trustee from June 2025 through May 2026, the Governing Board presented a Certificate of Appreciation and a ceremonial commencement sash to outgoing Student Trustee Sophie Khouri, who graduated from Middle College High School and Contra Costa College in late May.

#### **Employees Utilize Professional Development Opportunities**

The Governing Board received a report about 2025-26 Employee Participation in Professional Development Activities offered by 4CD. During the academic year, approximately 688 training and/or development opportunities were offered Districtwide.

#### **Governing Board Resolutions Adopted**

In honor of Asian American, Native Hawaiian, and Pacific Islander (AANHPI) Heritage Month and Mental Health Awareness Month, the Governing Board adopted two resolutions. The theme for AANHPI Heritage Month is "Power in Unity: Strengthening Communities Together." It honors the importance of leveraging collective power by focusing on unity to overcome challenges and storytelling to highlight the rich histories and experiences of AANHPI individuals. The theme of the Mental Health Awareness Resolution is "More Good Days, Together," which aims to build support systems, address mental health through community actions, create "good days" by supporting individuals as whole people, and reflect on what a "good" day looks like, both for ourselves and our communities.
