Governing Board Regular Meeting of August 12, 2026

The Contra Costa Community College District (4CD) Governing Board conducted a regular meeting on Wednesday, August 12, 2026, beginning at 4:00 p.m., followed by closed session, and continuation of the public session at 6:00 p.m.

Update on Student Enrollment and Success Trends

Research Director Dr. Z Reisz and Vice Chancellor, Education and Technology Kelly Schelin presented a special report providing an overview of recent trends related to student enrollment and success, with an emphasis on headcount, full-time equivalent students (FTES), enrollment and success data, and attendance accounting updates. Enrollment data and course success rates were also displayed according to demographics, such as race/ethnicity, gender, age group, and first-generation status. Introduction of Three-Year Districtwide International Education Strategic Plan

Dr. Mandy Liang, Associate Vice Chancellor Educational Services, shared with the Governing Board a three-year International Education Strategic Plan (IESP). The 2027-2030 IESP is aligned with the 2025-2030 4CD Strategic Plan and was developed through extensive stakeholder engagement. It provides an actionable roadmap organized around three strategic goals: enhancing international student success through holistic support services, strengthening a coordinated and sustainable Districtwide infrastructure for international education, and enriching campus communities through internationalization.
