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Mission

Kaiser Permanente Senior Advantage Plan

Cabinet received a presentation by Kaiser Permanente representatives on a program called Senior Advantage that could provide enhanced health coverage to some retirees and save the District money.

Developing the 09-10 Budget

Cabinet discussed principles for developing the 09-10 budget given recent reductions as a result of the state fiscal crisis. In addition, a new District budget allocation model is being developed, along with revisions to Business Procedure 18.02, <u>Guidelines for College Allocations</u> which will include a management allocation formula.

Districtwide Leadership Development Program

Cabinet continued making revisions to the new Districtwide Leadership Development Program slated to begin in January 2010. The program will be open to managers, classified and faculty, and include participants from all District locations.

60th Anniversary Book Event

Cabinet was updated on plans for a 60th anniversary book event that will publicly unveil the history book for which retiree Bill Harlan served as editor.

Recognition of Datatel Process Expert Team Members

Cabinet agreed to formally recognize the employees who are participating in the Datatel process expert team training and process improvement efforts.
