Mission

Given the challenging economic times, Cabinet agreed with a recommendation to delay the implementation of the classification study until later this year.

Districtwide Sustainability Presentation

Cabinet received a presentation by Julie Phillips on DeAnza College's sustainability efforts. A draft Governing Board policy was reviewed and received Cabinet input, and sustainability updates from the colleges and District Office were shared.

Faculty Diversity Recruitment

A draft initiative was presented to Cabinet on how the District could recruit diverse faculty to mirror the changing student population and enhance the learning experience.

Projected Budget Reductions for 2010-11

Projected 2010-11 budget reductions for the colleges and District Office/Districtwide Services were shared with the Cabinet, and included discussion on looming unfunded liabilities such as accrued vacation and banked load.
