Enrollment Update

Cabinet received an update from DVC's Beth Hauscarriague on new enrollment tracking tools available on the portal that are used to build the 320 report filed with the State Chancellor's office.

IT Infrastructure and Telephony Update

A progress report was given by Satish Warriar to Cabinet on the District's infrastructure and telephony project. Following contract approval by the Governing Board, the project is expected to take 18 months to complete.

Funding for Federally Mandated Services for Disabled Students

Mojdeh Mehdizadeh gave Cabinet a report on the challenges of providing mandated disabled student services at the colleges given the current budget climate.

Lease-Leaseback Option Discussion
