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Mission

District's Financial Review

Cabinet continued to review the District's allocation model to ensure the framework is fair and equitable. Suggestions for revisions are being shared with the Governing Board and the shared governance process. In addition, Cabinet reviewed the District impact of the recently approved 2011-12 state budget.

Achievement Gap Subcommittee Report

The Achievement Gap subcommittee assigned to implementing no and low-cost strategies in 2011-12 provided Cabinet with an update on their progress. The subcommittee received Cabinet support to implement a pilot program focusing on late enrollees at one college in spring 2012, with the goal of rolling out the program at all three colleges in fall 2012.

Cabinet reviewed and gave final approval to Human Resources Procedure 1080.02, <u>Heat</u> <u>Illness Prevention Program</u>.
