### Mission

## **Enrollment Management Discussion**

Cabinet convened an expanded conversation with college business officers and instructional officers in preparation for program and service cuts should the Governor's tax initiative not pass.

#### **Cost Savings Proposals**

Cabinet agreed to learn more about several cost saving proposals including an option to replace aging equipment with new energy efficient equipment.

#### **TAA Grant Update**

An update was given to Cabinet on the District's selection to receive a \$14.9 million Trade Adjustment Act grant that involves a consortium of 10 community colleges.

#### **Bond Refunding Update**

Cabinet received an update on discussions to refund existing bonds, and the placement of a resolution on the October 10, 2012, Governing Board meeting agenda for approval to move forward.

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
