Mission

Immigration Legal Services

Cabinet provided support for the District to submit a letter of interest for a grant to provide immigration legal services at all three colleges.

Out-of-State Enrollment

Cabinet was briefed on the issue that California community colleges do not have a reciprocal agreement with other state higher education institutions to serve out-of-state students. This places the District out-of-compliance with federal regulations, and Cabinet discussed options to pursue.
