### Mission

### Health Screening Software

Cabinet heard a presentation on Healthy Roster, a new screening software for COVID-19 to be used by college athletic departments. This is just one of several measures being taken to all student athletes resume training and conditioning at the colleges.

### Return-to-work Plans

Cabinet continued discussing plans to open the college campuses should state and county ordinances be lifted and allow students to return.

### International Education

Cabinet discussed the impact of the recent U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE) guidance on denying international students to attend colleges which are 100% online for the fall semester. ICE later rescinded that guidance, although it remains to be seen if new guidance will allow new international students to take 100% online classes.

### Microsoft Licensing

Cabinet agreed to continue providing Microsoft access to part time faculty and purchasing a new Microsoft security suite.
