Mission

Summer/Fall 2021 Schedules

Cabinet discussed the approach to planning course offerings for the summer and fall 2021 semesters, and reached consensus to offer online and hybrid courses with some in-person shadow course should conditions allow.

Statewide Technology Resources

Cabinet continued the conversation over the issue that a number of state-funded technology resources will no longer be funded as early as January 2021, and the costs must be absorbed by the District should those technologies be continued.
