### Mission

### Pandemic Updates

### Enrollment Recovery Program

### District Audit

Mojdeh indicated the District Auditor, Crowe LLP, has agreed to resume the audit following actions taken by the Governing Board. Their work will resume on April 4, 2022, with an expected completion date of June 30, 2022.

### Local 1 Chief Negotiator

Cabinet met Toni Sommer, a consultant and former community college vice president, to assist the District with upcoming labor negotiations with Local 1.
