### Mission

### Cabinet Meeting Schedule and Retreat

Cabinet reached consensus on the 2023-24 meeting schedule to hold two meetings a month, with the second one held in-person. Cabinet also agreed to conduct a retreat during summer 2023.

### 2023-24 Parking Fees

Cabinet discussed the possibility of reinstating parking fees at the colleges to help pay for parking officers and upgrades to parking lots and agreed to start enforcing parking fees beginning summer 2023.

### JobLinks 2023

Cabinet supported the annual JobLinks event to be held at DVC on June 1, 2023.

### Volz Company

Cabinet continued hearing updates from the Volz Company, who was selected to assist the colleges in developing their Facilities Master Plans. Since only one college project could be submitted, consensus was reached to push forward the LMC affordable student housing project for consideration.
