### Mission

### EEO Training

Cabinet discussed the opportunity to offer Equal Employment Opportunity training so that more trained EEO officers can be available for new hires particularly in the adjunct faculty ranks.

### Vaccine Mandate Change

Given the changes at the state and county level, Cabinet reached consensus to recommend to the Governing Board of suspending the 4CD vaccine mandate.

### Hispanic Serving Institutions (HSI)

Cabinet heard a presentation by CCC's Lorena Gonzalez on the importance of our colleges being designated as an HSI institution, and offered suggestions on how we can continue improving our efforts in serving this population.

### Revisions to 4CD EEO Plan

Cabinet provided input and guidance on updating the District's Equal Employment Opportunity Plan that must now be alignment with new State Chancellor guidelines.
