4CD Leadership Institute (4CDLI) Participants Present Group Projects

Over the course of two Chancellor's Cabinet meetings – on April 7 and April 21 – the 25 employee participants of the 4CDLI presented their group projects.

Group 1: Proposed a way to help struggling or marginalized students meet their educational goals using digital badges for key programs, tools (i.e., Parchment, EOPS, Canvas) and resources in the District to feel better supported in their educational journey.

Group 2: Proposed expanding embedded tutoring across low-success-rate courses to increase student success and completion rates and meet the District's strategic goals.

Group 3: Proposed developing an interactive visual tool called The Pathway Explorer which gives students a way to plan their educational path and would help with selecting the correct classes toward a certificate or degree.

Group 4: Proposed launching a student-driven podcast to provide a voice for students, specifically for under-represented populations, through the publication of topical issues and promoting events and other news across the colleges.

Group 5: Proposed expanding childcare services in the evening to allow working students/parents the ability to take evening classes.
