Dr. Tia Robinson-Cooper Resigns as Contra Costa College President

Contra Costa Community College District (4CD) Interim Chancellor Mojdeh Mehdizadeh confirms she has received the resignation of Dr. Tia Robinson-Cooper as President of Contra Costa College (CCC) effective June 30, 2022.

“I will be relocating outside Northern California, closer to my family who need my immediate support,” said Dr. Robinson-Cooper. “I greatly appreciate the opportunity I have had to serve the College community over the past year. I wish each of you the very best in the future.”

CCC Vice President of Instruction Dr. Kimberly R. Rogers has been appointed Acting President. Given the summer timeframe with many faculty members and others away, Dr. Rogers will help identify and lead a transition team until there is an opportunity to confer and work with college constituency leaders in the fall semester to listen, discuss options, and lay out a longer-term path for the future.

“On behalf of myself and the Governing Board, I want to thank Dr. Robinson-Cooper for her service to CCC and the 4CD,” said Interim Chancellor Mehdizadeh.
