(October 9, 2019: 9:15am)

PG&E continues to implement the public safety power shutoff event due to projected gusty winds and dry conditions that will affect parts of Contra Costa County. ***As of now, none of our District locations are affected. All locations are open and classes are in session.*** We will continue to provide updates as they are available.

(October 8, 2019: 2:30pm)

PG&E has notified Contra Costa County (County) for a possible power shutoff event due to gusty winds and dry conditions that will affect parts of the County. ***Current projections indicate none of our District locations will be affected. All locations are open and classes are in session.***

PG&E's Public Safety Power Shutoff may start as early as 12:00 a.m. midnight on Wednesday, October 9th, through Thursday, October 10th, at 12:00 p.m. According to PG&E, complete power restoration may take one to five days.

If there is a power shutoff event, residences, schools, local businesses, etc. in some County areas may be impacted. Check PG&E's website at www.pge.com for a current map of the impacted area and customer updates.
