

60th Anniversary Book



The District's 60th anniversary celebration culminated with the public unveiling of a book entitled "Sharing Memories: Contra Costa Community College District 1948-2008." An energetic crowd of approximately 100 people convened at the Craneway Pavilion in Richmond to purchase copies of the book and have them signed by guest contributors who were in attendance.

"The opportunity to edit and help write this book was quite an experience," said former faculty member, faculty leader and administrator Bill Harlan. "We were fortunate to have so many people willing to share their time and memories with us, that the result is a wonderful testament to the legacy of this District. It doesn't matter if you are a new employee or have 40 years of service, I'm sure you will learn something new about the District after reading the book."

The Craneway Pavilion was selected as the venue because it is located next to the former Kaiser Shipyard where some of the first District classes were held in 1949.

Copies of the book will be available for purchase at the college bookstores beginning in November 2009. Reference copies will also be accessible at the college and county libraries beginning next month.

Police Services Building Dedication

The Contra Costa Community College District Police Services Department hosted a dedication ceremony for their new Police Services building on Thursday, October 1, 2009, located on the DVC campus. The building replacement was necessary following an arson fire which occurred on June 23, 2008, destroying the former Police Services building.

The Contra Costa Community College District, founded in 1948 and governed by a publicly elected five-member board, is one of the largest multi-college community college districts in California. The mission of the District is to transform and enhance the lives of students, and through them, the communities served.

Chief **Charles Gibson** stated, "Sometimes a curse can turn into a blessing and the old building being burned down was the curse, however this beautiful new building is the blessing that came from it."

Tours of the facility were conducted, as the District celebrated the re-opening with a ribbon-cutting ceremony, refreshments and equipment displays. The ceremony also included the swearing-in ceremony for newly promoted Sergeant **Ryan Huddleston**. Chief Gibson and staff are excited to once again have a permanent headquarters.
