The fall semester kicked off with All-College Day (ACD) celebrations on Friday, August $18^{\rm th}$.

The morning included discussion around LMC's Educational Master Plan and Plan for Student Equity and Achievement, followed by a student panel, focused on the student's perspective of connectedness with the college.

4CD Begins Implementation of Zoom Phones

The 4CD IT department has begun the process of transitioning from traditional desk phones to the use of



Zoom phones districtwide. Beginning Labor Day weekend, the District Office will be the first site to move to the new system. Employee and department phone numbers will remain the same, as well as the ability to manage answering calls from the queue. In addition, Zoom phones provide the added ability to send text messages. The rollout for the colleges will be done primarily over holiday weekends to reduce the impact on both students and employees.

The transition schedule for each site will be as follows:

- September 1 (Labor Day Weekend): District Office
- September 8: DVC San Ramon Campus
- October 6 October 9 (Indigenous People's Day Weekend): Contra Costa College
- November 10 November 12 (Veteran's Day Weekend): Los Medanos College Pittsburg and Brentwood
- Winter Break: DVC Pleasant Hill Campus

4CD Expands Free Tuition Program

When the First-Time, Full-Time, Free Tuition (FT3) program first began in 2018, it was limited to students who had not previously enrolled in college. Due to changes in the law, 4CD has now renamed the program "Full-Time, Free Tuition" program, offering free tuition to all full-time students who meet the eligibility criteria.

By removing the first-time requirement, returning students are now eligible for free tuition while attending full-time at 4CD colleges for up to two academic years. Students who have received one year of tuition from the FT3 program may be eligible for up to one additional year of free tuition. Students will no longer have to complete the pledge and can click "accept" on their financial aid tile instead.
