Hispanic Americans/Latine make up 27 percent of Contra Costa County's adult population, 23 percent of 4CD's full and part-time employees, including its student employees, and 35 percent of 4CD's student population during fall 2022. CCC Hosts Investiture for 15th President

n September 26, 2023, Contra Costa College (CCC) hosted an Investiture Ceremony for CCC's 15th permanent president, Dr. Kimberly Rogers. Dr. Rogers, after being hired as CCC's Vice President of Instruction, took over as acting President, and was selected as CCC's permanent President earlier this year.

The celebration included comments from Interim Chancellor **Mojdeh Mehdizadeh**, 4CD Governing Board Vice-President John E. Márquez, who presented Dr. Rogers with a medallion, investing her with the symbol of her office. Following the presentation of the medallion, attendees heard from CCC Foundation President Anne O, Classified Senate President **Stephanie Figueroa**, Academic Senate President **Dr. Gabriela Segade**, CCC Associated Student Union President Sudinma Thap, and two distinguished CCC alumni, Abel Pineda, who now serves as the Mayor of San Pablo, and Alex Walker-Griffin, Mayor of Hercules.

Also in attendance were Dr. Helen Benjamin, CCC's 9th permanent President and former Chancellor, and McKinley Williams, CCC's 10th permanent President, as well as many elected officials.
