Where Needs are Greatest

Providing support to students via the Enduring Impact Campaign will allow us to target funding to one of several areas, such as food insecurity with subsidized financial support, students' scholarships, emergency funds covering financial needs that obstruct the ability to stay in school, and other programmatic support on our campuses.

With public relief funding harder to access, private philanthropy is vital for students to stay in class and join our workforce.

The Need is Real

Many 4CD students face daily financial challenges:

- 47%** of students are low-income
- 31%** are first-generation college students
- 13%** are single parents
- 68%** experience at least one basic-need insecurity

Philanthropic help matters. To be a full time student in 4CD, the total average annual cost including tuition, fees, housing, food, transportation, books, supplies and personal expenses is

Economic Value for Contra Costa County

4CD is an economic engine that generates **\$2.3 billion** annually for Contra Costa County. Each graduate contributes to the region's workforce, and associate degree holders earn about **\$11,500** more annually than high school graduates, creating lasting economic mobility for students and their families.

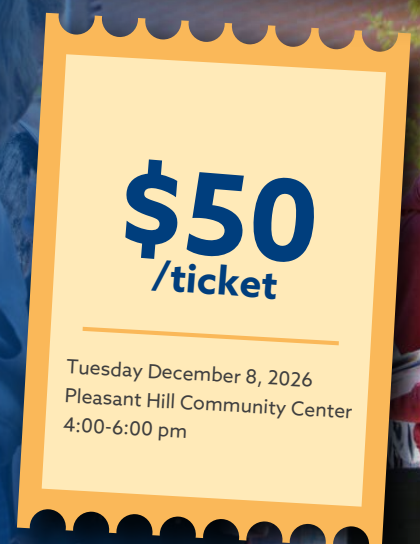
