REMEDIAL UNIT LIMIT POLICY

REGULATION

Title 5, Section 55035 states that no student shall receive more than 30 semester units (or 45 quarter units) of credit for remedial coursework unless excepted as explained herewith. Pursuant to Title 5, Section 55000 (t)(u), noncredit basic skills courses are those courses in reading, writing, computation, and English as a Second Language which are designated by the community college district as noncredit courses. Nondegree-applicable basic skills courses are those courses in reading, writing, computation, and English as a Second Language which are designated by the community college district as nondegree-applicable credit courses.

A student who transfers to a Contra Costa community college from a college outside of the District begins with a "clean slate" with regard to the basic skills limitation. Students transferring within the Contra Costa Community College District will accumulate basic skills units and all such units will count toward the basic skills limitation.

EXEMPTIONS

A student who is enrolled in one or more courses in English as a Second Language (ESL) or who is identified as having a learning disability as defined by Title 5, Section 55035 (c)(1)(2) is exempted from the limitation on basic skills course work.
