

COUNSELING SERVICES

The Contra Costa Community College District shall provide and publicize a counseling program at each college.

The counseling programs shall include, but not be limited to:

1. Academic counseling to assist the student in assessing, planning and implementing his or her immediate and long-range academic goals.
2. Career counseling to assist the student in assessing his or her aptitudes, abilities and interests and to provide advice regarding current and future employment trends.
3. Personal counseling to assist students with personal, family or other social concerns when that assistance is related to the student's education.

Counseling shall be coordinated with other student services, such as those provided for students with special needs, skills testing programs, financial assistance programs and job placement services.

Counseling services shall be provided to first-time students enrolled in more than six (6) units, students enrolled provisionally, and students on academic or progress probation.
